

**STATUTORY DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 31(6) HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**Re The Stockham Estate at Wantage Oxfordshire**

I, **WILLIAM MAITLAND WASBROUGH** of Stockham House Wantage Oxfordshire OX12 9BG ("Mr Wasbrough") and **GEORGE MEDWAY UNWIN YOUNG** ("Mr Young") and **NICHOLAS DAVID TURNER** ("Mr Turner") both of 10 Great James Street London WC1N 3DQ do respectively **SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE** as follows:

1. I, Mr Wasbrough, am the freehold owner of the land forming part of the Stockham Estate at Wantage Oxfordshire shown edged red on the plan now produced and shown to me and marked "Stockham Plan" (referred to below as "the Exhibited Plan") and I was until the 29 February 1984 the freehold owner of the land forming part of the said Stockham Estate shown edged orange on the Exhibited Plan.
2. We, Mr Young and Mr Turner, are and have been since the 29 February 1984 the freehold owners (as Trustees of a Settlement created by Mr Wasbrough) of the said part of the Stockham Estate shown edged orange on the Exhibited Plan which is now produced and shown to us and marked "Stockham Plan"
3. On the 14 January 1993 we deposited with Oxfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement dated 13 January 1993 accompanied by three plans numbered 1, 2 and 3 showing edged red on the plans numbered 1 and 3 the freehold property owned by me, Mr Wasbrough, and on the plan numbered 2 the freehold property owned by us, Mr Young and Mr Turner. The land edged red on the said plans numbered 1 and 3 is the same as the land edged red on the Exhibited Plan (subject to very minor variations which do not affect the present purposes of this declaration) and the land edged red on the said plan numbered 2 is the same as the land edged orange on the Exhibited Plan.
4. In the said statement it was stated that:
  - (a) the public has a right of way over the footpaths and bridleways which are marked purple and green respectively on the plan numbered 1 attached to the said statement and also on the Exhibited Plan and that the public does not have any right of way over the land shown edged red on the plan numbered 3 attached to the said statement (which forms part of the land edged red on the Exhibited Plan)
