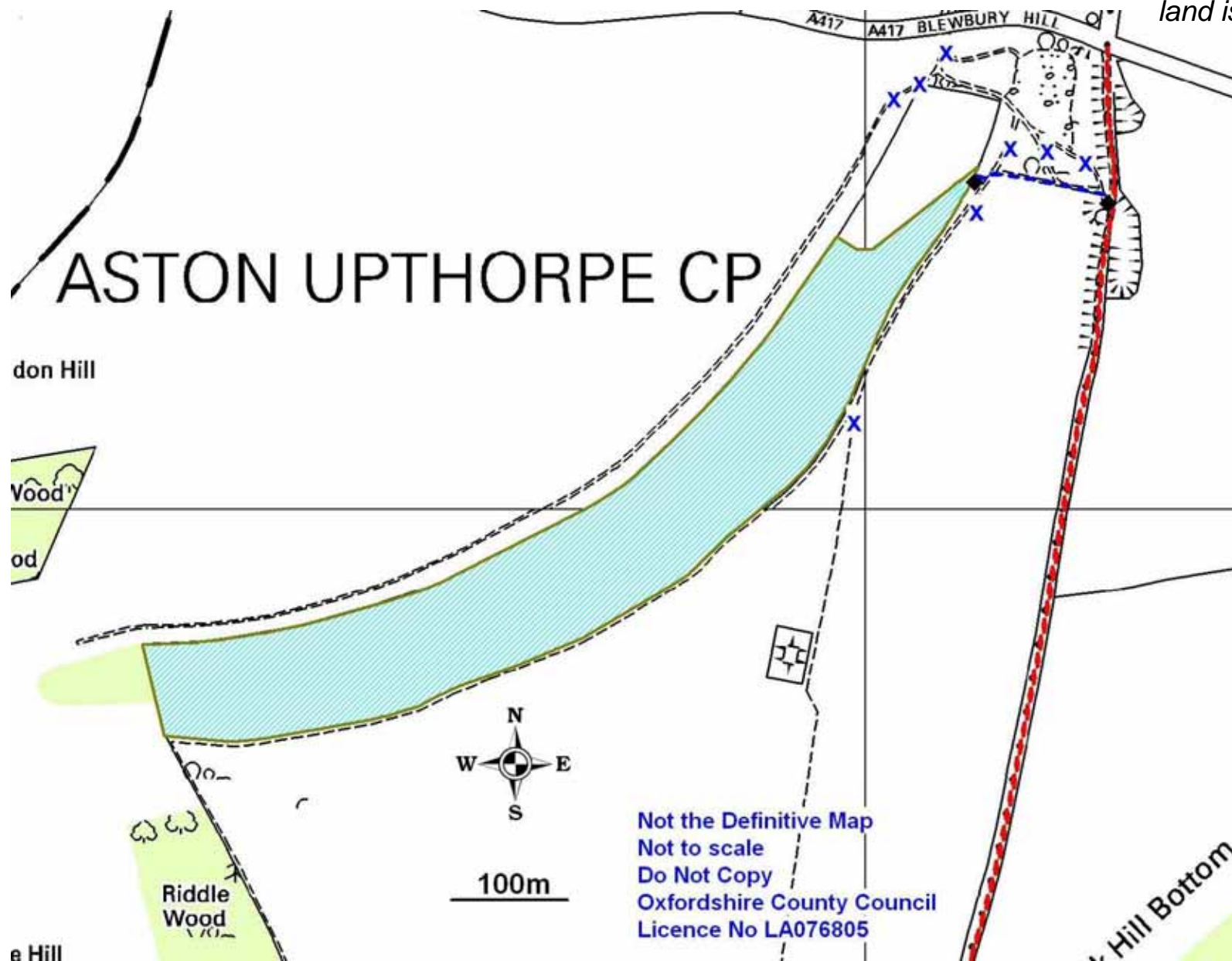


# Access Land - Lids Down

Welcome to this area of access land. This map shows access land in pale blue, and is derived from Natural England's Conclusive Map of Access Land. This site is an area of lowland chalk downland with varied flora and birdlife. The land is farmed to encourage this diversity - so please control your dog and please do not leave litter.

## Local Information

- Dogs to be kept on lead when livestock are grazing and during the bird nesting season (April to August)
- Please ensure gates are closed and latched shut
- You cannot cycle, ride a horse, ride a motorcycle or any motor vehicle on this land
- From time to time access may have to be restricted to protect livestock, wildlife, or You, so please take notice of any signs saying that land is closed
