"SPC would make the following representation on the Core Strategy with specific reference to the envisaged expansion of gravel extraction at Caversham/Sonning Eye:

1) Such expansion would be patently contrary to the objectives set out in the Minerals Plan Vision and supporting Policies, namely:-

-to minimise the distance by road between source and market....because Sonning Eye is at the furthest end of the county from where the product is needed and is separated from these development areas by Reading, Henley and an inadequate road infrastructure;

-to minimise the transport impact....because the local road infrastructure is already under stress and Henley is already subject to unacceptable traffic pollution and congestion;

-to minimise flood risk....because this is of course a Flood Risk Zone 3 area and-as experienced in winter 2013/14-is subject to extreme flood impact and access road closure/subsidence;

-to protect naturally important landscapes.

2) With specific reference to this latter issue, we would point out that such expansion would be directly contrary to the Adopted South Oxfordshire Landscape Assessment Policy, of which sections 11 a and b Thames Valley and Fringes delineate the area as strong on scenic quality and to be conserved....and (to quote the policy) "large scale development of any kind will be inappropriate along the river corridor" and (specifically) "where there is a need to repair the landscape setting of the river corridor from the effects of gravel extraction (eg east of Caversham)".

"Finally, SPC would express its support of the comprehensive representation submitted by OXAGE (Oxfordshire Against Gravel Extraction"
