It argues that if OCC had carried out the LAA properly, then currently permitted sites already in existence would have sufficient reserves to meet Oxfordshire's needs for the next 10 years, i.e. there would be no need for new sand and gravel pits anywhere in Oxfordshire. In addition the local councils and public have not been fully consulted on the LAA.
