HCC supports *Policy W6: Landfill* which would not only satisfy the requirement for landfilled waste in Oxford but will also provide capacity for other authorities such as Hampshire. In 2013, Hampshire provided approximately 29,500 tonnes of landfilled waste to Oxfordshire.

This demonstrates the plan to be positively prepared and effective.

HCC supports *Policy W8: Management of Agricultural Waste* which allows for the construction of anaerobic digestion facilities. Half of waste deposited in Hampshire from Oxfordshire is processed via anaerobic digestion, this allows for waste to be processed close to its source and is consistent with national policy.

Oxfordshire County Council engaged with Hampshire County Council in the spirit of Duty to Cooperate regarding transboundary waste movements in September 2014 and mineral movements in April 2015. This demonstrates collaborative working with other minerals and waste planning authorities and is consistent with national planning policy.
