***WTC/111/15 OXFORDSHIRE MINERALS AND WASTE LOCAL PLAN: PART1 –
CORE STRATEGY ADVANCE NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON
PROPOSED SUBMISSION DOCUMENT AUGUST 2015***

The Town Council considered a report from Councillor Cooper on this consultation document with four recommendations he believed should be made to Oxfordshire Minerals and Waste Local Plan. These recommendations were proposed by Cllr Cooper and seconded by Cllr Yoxall and Council

RESOLVED (unanimously) to recommend OCC to

- (i) Explore the possibility of the Cotswold Line being used for transportation of sand and gravel extraction.
- (ii) Ask OCC to use every measure possible to reduce the number of trips to Slape Hill waste transfer station.
- (iii) Support policy M4 (j) keeping extraction sites away from Blenheim.
- (iv) Propose an amendment policy M7 so that the County Council is against fracking.
