

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WOODSTOCK STREET FAIR)
(SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2024**

WHEREAS Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) is satisfied that on the grounds of public safety, vehicular traffic in certain roads should be prohibited or restricted and alternative routes provided to enable the annual Woodstock Street Fair (“the Event”) to take place. The Council is satisfied it is not practical to hold the event other than on the road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Save as provided by article 3, except under the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or the Council or District Council, no person shall, when and where appropriate signage is in place, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the sections of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order.
2. Save as provided by Article 3, except under the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or the Council or District Council, no person shall, when and where appropriate signage is in place, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the sections of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to proceed in any of the roads specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order, or wait in any of the sections of road specified in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order if the vehicle is being used:
 - (a) for Police, Fire and Ambulance services,
 - (b) in connection with the setting up or dismantling of the Event,
 - (c) to enable access to premises adjacent to and accessible from, and only from such sections of road,
 - (d) in connection with emergency works to any sewer or to any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or telecommunications in, or on any land adjacent to a section of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
 - (e) in the case of article 2 above, and Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, to set down or pick up passengers, or to allow a vehicle to be loaded or unloaded, where it is not practical to do so elsewhere.
4. The sections of road specified in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order are subject to the temporary removal of permitted waiting in the said roads.

5. The prohibitions imposed by Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall apply in relation to any part of the sections of roads to such extent and at such times as there are in place traffic signs (within the meaning of section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) indicating that such prohibition is in operation at that part.
6. The relevant parts of the following orders shall be temporarily suspended insofar as they are affected by the restrictions applied to the Sections of Road specified in Parts 2 and 3 of the Schedule this order:
 The Oxfordshire County Council (Woodstock - Various Roads) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) Order 2023 (as amended);
 The Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2006 (as amended) article 11 (1) (d) and Schedule 1.
7. This Order may be cited as The Oxfordshire County Council (Woodstock Street Fair) (Special Event) Order 2024 and shall come into force on 6th October 2024.

Prohibition of vehicles:

- (a) Market Street,
 - (b) Market Place,
 - (c) High Street,
 - (d) Park Street,
- for their entire lengths.

Part 2.

Prohibition of Waiting:

Market Street	South side	for its entire length
Market Place	South side	west of Town Hall
High Street	Both sides, including the traffic island at the junction with Oxford Road.	for their entire lengths

Park Street	North side, from its junction with Browns Lane,	westwards for a distance of 27 metres;
	South side, from its junction with Market Place	to a point 30 metres east of its junction with Rectory Lane.
