## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD CITY, VARIOUS STREETS) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) (FILMING - SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2024

**WHEREAS** the Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") is satisfied that vehicular traffic should be temporarily prohibited from using certain lengths of road in Oxford City centre to facilitate film production ("the Event").

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers make the following Order.

- Save as provided by Article 2 of this Order, no person shall when and where appropriate signage is in place, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civilian enforcement officer, cause a vehicle or cycle (as the case may be) to proceed or wait in parts of the following "Sections of Roads":
  - (1) Catte Street;
  - (2) King Edward Street;
  - (3) New College Lane;
  - (4) Merton Street:
  - (5) Oriel Square;
  - (6) Queens Lane;
  - (7) Radcliff Square
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to proceed in the Sections of Road, insofar as the safety and progress of the Event is concerned if the vehicle is:
  - (1) being used for the purpose of police, fire or ambulance services in an emergency;
  - (2) being used in connection with emergency works to the road or any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or to any electronic communication apparatus in or near the road;
  - (3) of whatever description or use and is necessary for or in support of the Event;
  - (4) controlled access to premises in the Sections of Roads.
- 3. The prohibition imposed by Article 1 shall apply in relation to any part of the Sections of Roads to such extent and at such times as there are in place traffic signs (within the meaning of section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) indicating that such prohibition is in operation at that part.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford City, Various Streets) (Prohibition of Vehicles) (Filming-Special Event) Order 2024 and shall have effect from 20 August 2024.
