The event includes cycling, running and swimming.

The Council is satisfied that it is not appropriate for the event to take place wholly off road.

The effect of the order is to temporarily prohibit vehicles from proceeding or waiting between 8.30am and 3.30pm on 14 September in -

- 1) The road from the B4526 Reading Road (Goring Heath) south-eastwards to Sheepways Lane (Trench Green);
- 2) Mill Lane, southwards from the above road to Mapledurham Road;
- 3) On Mapledurham Road from the Village to Mill Lane

Exemptions to the closures are included for participants and organisers emergency services and for vehicular access to property which is only accessible from the closed sections of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected is via Sheepways Lane, A4074 Reading Road, B4526 and vice-versa
