

# Determined changes to Designated/Catchment Areas from 1 September 2025

#### **Dunmore Primary School**

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- Northern boundary moved north from Dunmore Road to the A34 as far as the Pen Lane bridge (access route between Abingdon and Sunningwell) and then follows the fence line at the southern extent of Lodge Hill as far as Oxford Road. All addresses to the north of Dunmore Road and south of the A34 between Wootton Road and Oxford Road (with the exception of addresses at Lodge Hill) are now considered to be in the designated/catchment area. They are also in the designated/catchment areas of other school(s).
- Southern boundary moved north to the southern fence line of addresses on Collingwood Close between Darrell Way and Harcourt Way. No addresses have been added to or removed from the designated area due to this change.

# Long Furlong Primary School

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

The designated/catchment area for the school has been changed as follows:

 Northern boundary moved north from Dunmore Road following Pen Lane between Dunmore Road and the A34 adjacent to the Pen Lane bridge (access route between Abingdon and Sunningwell) and then follows the fence line at the southern extent of Lodge Hill as far as Oxford Road. All addresses bounded on the north by the fence line at the southern extent of Lodge Hill, on the east by Oxford Road, on the south by Dunmore Road and on the west by Pen Lane are now considered to be in the designated/catchment area. They are also in the designated/catchment areas of other school(s).

# **Longworth Primary School**

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- With the exception of addresses in the north of the civil parish of Longworth that are in Newbridge (on both sides of the River Thames) the whole of the civil parish is now included in the designated/catchment area.
- The south-eastern boundary no longer follows the tributary of the River Ock when it turns southwards towards the river. It follows the field boundary northwards to the lane running south of Sheephouse Farm: then eastwards on that lane to the eastern side of Sheephouse Farm and northwards along the farm track towards Southmoor At Newhouse Covert the boundary runs westwards to the brook and north-eastwards along the brook (excluding addresses at Newhouse Farm). The boundary continues to follow the brook past Overbrook Cottage (included in the new designated/catchment area) and then follows the field boundary northwards to the copse lying to the south of the new development at Wood Lane, Southmoor. The southern and eastern edges of the copse form the boundary and then the field boundary northwards to the south-eastern corner of the new development at Wellington Way, Southmoor. All addresses at Wellington Way, Bramley Close and Maclean Drive are included in the new designated/catchment area. All addresses at West Hayes (Faringdon Road) are not included in the new designated/catchment area. The boundary line follows Waggon Place (track) from Faringdon Road to the A420 footbridge which connects Wagdon Place to Harris's Lane. Longworth. It then follows the A420 eastwards along the civil parish boundary between Longworth and Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor.

### Mill Lane Primary School

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- The north-eastern boundary has moved north-eastwards to the western side of Thame Road (B4445). All addresses at Oxford Down and Windmill Close which were not already in the designated//catchment area are now included.
- To the east, the boundary runs along the party wall between 1A Mill Lane (now solely in the designated/catchment area) and 2 Station Road (now solely in the designated/catchment area of St Andrew's Churchy of England Primary School, Chinnor).
- To the east, the boundary line now follows the northern, western and southern edges of the Chinnor allotments (lying between Station Road to the east, Cherry Tree Road to the west, Van Diemens Close to the north and Oakley Road to the south), which places the allotments in the designated/catchment area of St Andrew's Church of England Primary School, Chinnor.
- To the south, the boundary line follows the fence line at the rear of addresses on Greenwood Avenue crossing Fritillary Avenue at that point. All addresses on Greenwood Avenue are included in the designated/catchment area while all addresses on Fritillary Avenue, Brimstone Road, Emperor Way and Swallowtail Road remain in the designated/catchment area of St Andrew's Church of England Primary School, Chinnor.

# Radley Church of England Primary School

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- On the west, the boundary follows the centre of Oxford Road (A4183). No addresses to the west of this road are included in the designated/catchment area.
- To the north-east, the boundary follows the eastern side of the railway line southwards to the southern boundary of the field marking the furthest limit of properties that can be accessed via Sandford Lane (the mast and sewage pumping station).
- On the east, the boundary follows the centre of the River Thames (Isis). No land on the eastern (Nuneham Courtenay) side of the river is included in the designated/catchment area.

#### St Andrew's Church of England Primary School, Chinnor

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- On the western side of the boundary within Chinnor, the boundary has moved northeastwards to the western side of Thame Road (B4445). All addresses at Oxford Down and Windmill Close which were previously considered to be in the designated/catchment area are now in the designated//catchment area of Mill Lane Primary School.
- On the western side of the boundary within Chinnor, the boundary runs along the party wall between 1A Mill Lane (now solely in the designated/catchment area of Mill Lane Primary School) and 2 Station Road (now solely in the designated/catchment area of St Andrew's Church of England Primary School, Chinnor).
- On the western side of the boundary within Chinnor, the boundary line now follows the northern, western and southern edges of the Chinnor allotments (lying between Station Road to the east, Cherry Tree Road to the west, Van Diemens Close to the north and Oakley Road to the south), which places the allotments in the designated/catchment area of St Andrew's Church of England Primary School, Chinnor.
- On the southern side of the boundary within Chinnor, the boundary line follows the fence line at the rear of addresses on Greenwood Avenue crossing Fritillary Avenue at that point. All addresses on Greenwood Avenue are included in the designated/catchment area of Mill Lane Primary School while all addresses on Fritillary Avenue, Brimstone Road, Emperor Way and Swallowtail Road remain in the designated/catchment area of St Andrew's Church of England Primary School, Chinnor.

### **Stockham Primary School**

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- To the north, the boundary follows Downsview Road from the roundabout to the service road on the eastern side of the Grove Business Park (between the business park and Fox Lane) and follows the service road southwards to Stockham Bridge on the former Wiltshire and Berkshire Canal at the north-east of Roach Bank. This places all addresses on Stockham Park (Whittington Crescent and surrounding estate and Badger Drive and surrounding estate) in the designated/catchment area.
- To the south-east, the boundary runs along The Wharf to Mill Street and then westwards along Mill Street and Challow Road. All addresses on Mill Street that are to the east of Letcombe Brook have been removed from the designated/catchment area.

# **Stonesfield Primary School**

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

The designated/catchment area for the school has been changed as follows:

• To the north-east, the boundary has moved north-eastwards to include Wood Farm and surrounding area.

#### Sunningwell Church of England Primary School

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- On the east, the boundary follows the centre of Oxford Road (A4183). All addresses accessed from the northern side of Dunmore Road, Abingdon and from the western side of Oxford Road (including Lodge Hill) are in the designated/catchment area.
- On the west, all contiguous addresses at Foxcombe Hill are now included in the designated/catchment area. The boundary runs southwards through the private woodlands of Foxcombe Hall and westwards along the dividing edge between those woodlands and addresses on the northern side of Fox Lane (included in the designated/catchment area); then westwards on Fox Lane to Hill View and Blagrove Cottage (included in the designated/catchment area); then southwards and southwestwards along the eastern edge of the field to Blagrove Copse, crossing the copse at the narrowest point and southwards and south-westwards along the eastern and southern sides of the field to the track which leads to Blagrove Farm; crossing this track and following the water course to the track running between White Cross and Sunningwell; then following this track westwards to White Cross.

### Woodstock Church of England Primary School

Determined change to the designated area from 1 September 2025.

- On the north-east, the boundary has moved north-eastwards on the old Banbury Road to the junction with Wootton Road (B4027) at the Sewage Pumping Station, then westwards on Wootton Road (B4027). Weaveley Farm and surrounds on the southern side of Wootton Road (B4027) are now included in the designated/catchment area.
- On the north-east and north, the boundary continues along Wootton Road (B4027) past Sansom's Platt and including all addresses on both sides of the road at Sansom's Farm; then continuing along Wootton Road (B4027) past Hordley House and Hordley Farm and Barns (included in the designated/catchment area); then continuing north-westwards on Wootton Road (B4027) crossing the River Dorn at Milford Bridge; then continuing northwestwards on Wootton Road (B4027) to the track to Balliol Farm (included in the designated/catchment area); then north-westwards along the dividing line between the properties on the northern-eastern side of Glympton Road (B4027) and the field to their north-east (Glym Cottage, The Old Pink Cottage, Wayside, Woodlake Cottage, Beech Cottage, The Oxford Barn and The Blue Barn all included in the designated/catchment area); then north-westwards on Tew Lane to the southern edge of the copse lying between Tew Lane and Glympton Road (B4027).
- On the north, following the southern edge of the copse between Tew Lane and Glympton Road (B4027) crossing Glympton Road (B4027) to the south of Rose Cottage, Glympton (not included in the designated/catchment area); westwards along the track at the northern edge of the field boundary towards the River Glyme and continuing to follow the track southwards on the eastern side of the River Glyme past Swan's Nest to Slape Bridge on Woodstock Road (A44).
- On the north and north-west, crossing Woodstock Road (A44) and continuing to follow the River Glyme and the southern edge of Hark Wood through Slape Bottom; continuing along the southern edge of Glympton Wood to the north of Glympton Assarts Farm (included in the designated/catchment area) and then northwards along the western edge of Glympton Wood crossing the field to the north-eastern corner of Maisev's Copse: southwards along the eastern edge of Maisey's Copse and then following the track and path from Maisey's Copse through Round Brake (included in the designated/catchment area) and Callowhill Brake (included in the designated/catchment area) past Ditchley Dell (not included in the designated/catchment area) to Charlbury Road (B4437); following the track to Starveall Farm (included in the designated/catchment area) and continuing along the field boundary to the track which divides King's Wood (not included in the designated/catchment area) from Wootton Wood (included in the designated/catchment area); following the track through the forest to the southern edge of Wootton Wood and then eastwards along the southern edge of Wootton Wood to the north of Limbeck Farm and Cottages (not included in the designated/catchment area); crossing Blackgate Lane and continuing to follow the western edge of the woodland southwards to the original course of Akeman Street (Roman Road) crossing the Blenheim Estate.

#### Determined
